MUSHROOMS

(In the West Durham Review.) Deaths occur in this country every year owing to the fact that many people who use mushrooms at table are unable to distinguish with certainty the poisonous from the others.

These fungi, so called mushrooms or toadstools, or whatever else may be, in view of their use as food, classed into three groups - (1) those which are edible and good - (2) those which are poisonous - (3) those which are indifferent, neither poisonous or good.

The chief things to be kept in mind are the characters of the poisonous forms. These all, practically all, belong to one genus and have these points of distinction which may easily be recognized by everyone.

Avoid all the white-gilled and yellow-gilled mushrooms. Avoid all old or spoiled specimens of all kinds. The pink, black or brown-gilled are safe, though the pink is the most delicious. Puff balls are poisonous.

A few points of this character may often be made of service when appearing in the local papers. It is alright to have them stowed away in scientific books and monographs, but it is through the papers that it reaches the people.

Montreal's Spending Money. Montreal, Aug. 29 - According to figures prepared by the city auditor, Mr. Pelletier, the city will next year have at its disposal \$16,000,000 to spend. The report shows that \$8,100,000 of this amount will come out of revenues, such as real estate, taxes, water taxes, etc.
