Loan to Canada Safe as the Bank

LONDON, Nov. 14.—The Hon. Geo. E. Foster, Canadian minister of trade and commerce, referring to the attitude of the English financial world toward investments in the Dominion, said to-day, at a meeting of the Royal Colonial Institute, that the fault which lay in some of the criticisms of Londoners was that they looked upon Canada as a whole, while their criticisms ought to be confined to certain private or semi-private dotations.

Abolish Girl Slaves in Chinese Republic; Old System of Beauty Slaves Described

Canton, China, Nov. 14.—Chinese women are to-day no longer the slaves of men. The pretty girls of poverty cannot be purchased as dolls by the rich, and the daughters of the wealthy families no longer are forced to become wives of the sons of their fathers' peers.

In recent years Chinese women of the higher class only—those of the rich and educated—have had any social standing in public.

There are to-day in Canton many normal schools for young women. These are provided by the Government as a part of the public school system.

These Chinese women are by nature good in physique, but they are still harassed with their foot-binding, and they have many schools of physical training in the city.
