Corporation of the Town of Lindsay By-Law No. 49-4

Take notice that the above is a true copy of a proposed by-law which has been taken into consideration and which will finally be passed by the Corporation of the Town of Lindsay after one month from the first publication thereof in the Watchman-Warder, the date of the first publication being the sixth day of December, 1906, and that the votes of the said electors of the said Municipality will be taken thereon at the same hour, on the same day, at the same place, and by the same Deputy Returning Officers as for the municipal elections for the year 1907, as provided in the said by-law.

By-Law No. 49-4

A By-Law to Raise by way of Loan \$20,000.00 to improve the Water works System.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Lindsay has heretofore purchased and constructed under the Municipal Act and the Municipal Waterworks Act, a system of waterworks for the said Corporation and has raised the money for the purchase and construction thereof, upon the whole assessable property of the said Corporation under by-laws lawfully passed.

AND WHEREAS it is now necessary and desirable to extend and improve the said waterworks system by putting in a proper system of filtration and it has been estimated by the Board of Water Commissioners for the Town of Lindsay that the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars will be required for that purpose.

AND WHEREAS for the purpose aforesaid it is necessary to create a debt to the extent of \$20,000, and to issue debentures therefor in the manner hereinafter mentioned.

AND WHEREAS \$1537.53 is the annually by special rate for a period of twenty years for paying the said debt and interest thereon
