Corporation of the Town of Lindsay By-Law No. A By-Law to extend the Term of Office of all Members of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Lindsay to two years.

NOTICE. TAKE NOTICE that the above is a true copy of a proposed by-law which has been taken into consideration and which will finally be passed by the Corporation of the Town of Lindsay after one month from the first publication thereof in the Watchman-Warder, the date of the first publication being the sixth day of December, 1906, and that the votes of the said electors of the said Municipality will be taken thereon at the same hour, on the same day, at the same places, and by the same Deputy Returning Officers as for the municipal elections for the year 1907, as provided in the said by-law.

2. That the said debentures shall bear interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent per annum, payable on the Fifteenth day of December in each year, and may have attached thereto coupons for payment of the said interest, which coupons shall be signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer of the said Corporation, or the debentures may be levied in each year by special rate on all the rateable property in the Municipality of the Town of Lindsay, the sum of \$1587.53, for the purpose of paying the amount due in each of the said years for said principal and interest.

3. That there shall be raised and levied in each year by special rate on all the rateable property in the Municipality of the Town of Lindsay, the sum of \$1587.53, for the purpose of paying the amount due in each of the said years for said principal and interest.

7. That the votes of all the electors in the said Town of Lindsay entitled to vote on this by-law, shall be taken at the same hour, on the same day and at the same places as for the municipal elections for the year 1907, as provided in the said by-law.
