Major-General Robert Montreux Rogers, V. C. B., who has just died at Maldenhead, England, had a brilliant record. He served in the Crimea war up to the fall of Sebastopol, the China war of 1860, where he won the Victoria Cross by being the first Englishman to enter the Taku forts, and the Zulu war of 1879, where he commanded the 90th Light Infantry.

General Rogers was severely wounded at the storming of the Taku forts; his decorations for service in the field included the Crimean medal with clasps for Sebastopol, the Turkish medal, the China medal, and the Zulu medal with clasps. He was twice mentioned in despatches and thrice received promotion in special gallantry.

A Cape Town mail received at Plymouth says a panic prevailed at Lorezo Marquez, East Africa, in consequence of a disaster to the Portuguese force. Kaffirs entered the Portuguese camp at dawn, pretending that they were friends. Many of the soldiers were sleeping. Most of them were suffering from fever. The Kaffirs began killing them with assegais. Lieut. Manuel, while helping a fellow-officer to rouse the men, was stabbed in the back. 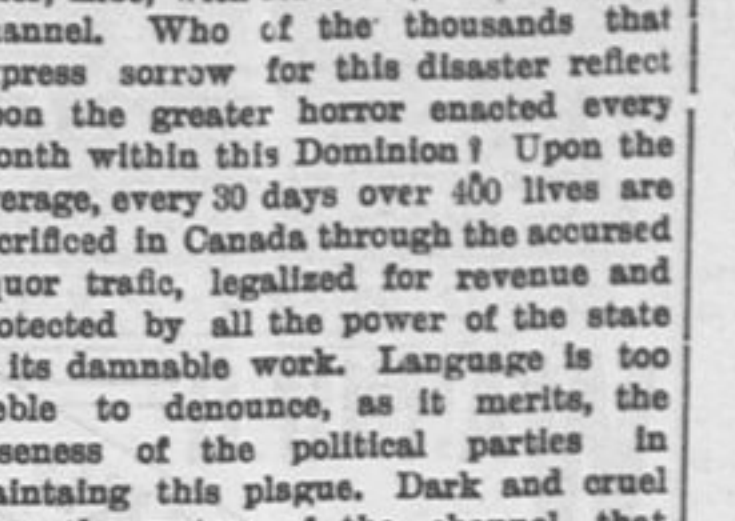
