EXPERIMENTAL SPRAYING. Farmers Need Have No Losses of Fruit if They Carefully Follow Instructions and Spray Trees at the Right Times.

The report of the Superintendent of Experimental Spraying for the province of Ontario for 1898 has just been received, and contains a good deal of valuable information for the farmer and fruit grower.

The ravages of insect pests of late years have been the cause of enormous losses to the owners of orchards, and the Ontario government have called in the aid of science to counteract the evil.

Mr. Orr's report gives many interesting and convincing details showing the entire efficacy of the system, recording in detail the results of experimental spraying conducted during the past season at thirty different points throughout the province.

The greatest interest was taken by the people of the localities selected, the attention of the spraying numbering 3,588 persons, in addition to many subsequent visitors to orchards sprayed—the number being 700 more than that of the year previous.

The plan was to spray when the buds were swelling, then just before the opening of the blossoms, and lastly, when the blossoms had fallen, at intervals of about twelve days, until the danger of frost was passed.

The result was a very marked improvement in the quality of the fruit, showing that the tent caterpillar and other insect pests had been vanquished by the treatment.

A rigid examination of the yield was made, and all scabby, wormy or other defective fruit rejected, and in many cases from 90 to 100 per cent of clean, sound fruit was obtained.

The long-continued heat and drought was unusually favorable to insects, and the ravages of the caterpillar and other vermin proved extremely destructive in all unsprayed orchards.

The report, which is a valuable exposition of the advantages of spraying, may be had on application to the Ontario department of agriculture.
