A Word About Timothy Seed. From careful germination tests made by Professor Goff, of the Wisconsin station, it has been found that the hulled grains of timothy seed neither germinate so well nor retain their vitality so long as those not hulled; also that timothy seed, when properly stored, is fairly reliable up to five years old.

All About Swine. Give the hogs plenty of slops. A little corn scattered in the field will give the hogs a good start.

When we begin to feed the pigs to fatten them we will get more growth and better meat to make the food one-fourth bran, three-fourths by weight of corn or rye.

How Superphosphate is Made. Ordinary superphosphate is made by dissolving 100 pounds of bone with 40 pounds of sulphuric acid (oil of vitriol). The bones will then be converted into sulphate of lime (plaster) and the phosphoric acid of the bones set free, being lost in the condition.
