WILL KICK AGAINST AN INCREASE

Our Councilors Discuss the Increase in the Town Assessment Reported by the County Valuers—The Election of a Committee to Represent the Town in the County Council.

The council met in committee of the whole Friday last to consider the assessment placed upon the town by the county valuers, which if confirmed, would considerably increase the amount of county tax to be paid by the town.

The members present were Mayor Smyth, Reeve Touchburn, Dep. Reeve Robson, and Couns. Southerton, Burrows, Horn, Pedlar, Killaly, Bryans and Baldwin.

The electric lighting contract was first taken up. Coun. Pedlar, chairman of the committee, explained that the company wished to know what the council desired before submitting figures.

The claim of Mrs. Jas. Wilson for damages was next discussed. The affidavit sworn to by her, that she had broken her leg on Queen-st., east ward, by a fall caused by a defective walk, that she had been unable to attend to her duties for 13 weeks; that she had been put to a large expense for medical attendance; and finally, that her husband had been compelled to give up work to nurse her.

The suggestion was adopted, and Messrs. Engelson and Pitkin were appointed, they being instructed to report to a committee meeting of the council on the evening of the 23rd.

THE CONVINCING ADDRESS DELIVERED BY OUR MEMBER DURING THE TARIFF TALK.

Below we give the official Hansard report of a speech recently delivered in the commons by our member, Mr. McHugh, during the long and fierce debates on the tariff.

Mr. Chairman, notwithstanding all I have heard for the last couple of days, I still venture to express myself in favor of the tariff resolutions now before this house. My reason for this approval is that I consider this a Canadian tariff.

It is a tariff made in the interests of the Canadian people, and concerted with the view to the welfare of all the existing and vying industries of the country. I see in this tariff protection against countries that will only deal with Canada in a grudging or unfriendly way.

Moreover, I see in the preferential schedule of this tariff a kind invitation extended to the countries of the world that wish to deal with us on an equal and friendly basis. They are told in these resolutions that Canada is ready to reciprocate with any country that wants to trade with us.

Hon. gentlemen who have alluded to this tariff according to the way in which it affected their respective callings; and I think the house will bear with me for a moment or two while I refer to it from the standpoint of the agriculturists.
