Thos. Jackson and Wm. Jordan, two highly respected and law-abiding citizens of that neighborhood, being allowed to stand under an unjust suspicion. We owe and under these gentlemen a handsome apology, being certain at the same time that their reputations for probity of character has not suffered in the estimation of all who know them because of our error.

Committed Suicide. We received the following letter the other day in accordance with the request contained therein, we publish it:—"A young woman named Miss Aggie Burns, a Canadian girl from Coboonk, Canada, arrived in Michigan July 18, 1893, as she was very sad and down-hearted and seemed troubled about something. She was working in a tailor shop. After dinner she told the foreman that she would not be back that day. She went out of the shop, and a few minutes after she was seen to get a revolver across the street. At the time she was found on the road-side of the main street with a bullet in her heart. The body, which was cold when found, was well dressed, and the features composed. The revolver lay by her right hand with two empty shells in it, and a note lying by her side stated that she had been thinking of wrong-doing in Coboonk and that she did not deserve it, and could not bear the thoughts of having her people think her guilty; she would rather die. She desired her body to be buried in the States, and wished the particulars of her death to be published in THE LINDSAY POST, and asked that people to not worry her parents, as she could not live in bed friends with her parents. She also said she was the second daughter of J. J. Burns, of Coboonk, Township of Berley.

A Narrow Escape. Monday morning last at about a quarter to three o'clock the loud clanging of the fire bell aroused Mr. T. O'Neill, jr., from refreshing slumber in his quarters in the fire hall, and in less than a minute the horses were harnessed to the hose wagon and headed for the burning building, which proved to be the residence of Mr. S. Ritchie, on Peel-st., two doors east of the Salvation army barracks. The firemen were quickly on the spot, and soon had a couple of streams playing upon the flames, but the building, being a wooden one, burned fiercely, and was reduced to a charred and smoking wreck by the time the last tongue of fire had been thrown out. The explosion of a lamp in the front hall is supposed to have been the cause of the fire. Mr. Ritchie had been asleep during the night and about 3 a. m. drank some beer and made for herself a drink of cognac. Thinking she might need the light she left it upon a table in the hall and returned. Some time afterwards she was awakened by the movements of the baby, and discovered that the horse was on fire. Mr. Ritchie and the other members of the family were speedily aroused, and upon essaying to escape by the stairs found the hall all ablaze. The window in the front upstairs room was then removed, and after throwing out some bedding to lighten the children and Mrs. Ritchie were lowered to arm's length and then dropped a distance of seven or eight feet, or were caught by those standing below. Some few pieces of clothing and furniture were saved, but the family had to make their escape in their night clothes. The contents were insured in the British American Co. for \$240, and the building or \$900.
