MR. BALFOUR'S DEAD

BADE ALL HIS FAMILY FAREWELL

Fully a Short Time Before the Long Sleep of Death Fell Upon Him—His Career From Newbury to Crown Adviser—The Cause of His Poor Health.

Toronto, Aug. 26. A second time has the huge legislative pile in Queen's Park become the death-chamber of a member of the Ontario Government.

Yesterday morning, Mr. Balfour seemed stronger than he had been for days, and Dr. Fisher of Amherstburg went so far as to hold out hopes of his patient's recovery.

Shortly after 5 o'clock the attendant says that the hand of death was approaching and summoned the members of the dying man's family to his bedside.

It seems especially sad that Mr. Balfour should be cut off while comparatively a young man—he had only reached his 45th year—when he had just arrived at the goal which for years he had been struggling towards.

When a boy, not yet in his teens, Mr. Balfour sold newspapers to pay for the text books he needed at school.

He was camping on an island in Georgian Bay, and none of the messages concerning Mr. Balfour's illness reached him until late on Tuesday night, when it was too late to catch a train for Toronto.

On his arrival, the Premier hurried to the Speaker's chambers, where Mr. Balfour lay since Monday night, and conducted with him the last rites.

It is understood that the available Cabinet Ministers will be among the pallbearers at the funeral which will be held at the funeral home.

AN ARMY CORPS ARRESTED

HOW TO GROW WHEAT

An Interesting Bulletin Issued From the O. A. C.

TESTS MADE BY MR. C. A. ZAVITZ.

The Record of Experiments Made During the Past Seven Years With Many Varieties of Winter Wheat—Yield of Wheat and Straw—A Study for Farmers.

Toronto, Aug. 26. Bulletin 102, just issued by the Ontario Agricultural College, gives experiments made by C. A. Zavitz, B.S.A., in winter wheat.

One hundred and thirty-three varieties of winter wheat have been tested at the Ontario Agricultural College within the last seven years. Of this number fifty-three varieties have been grown for five years, and the remainder have been tested from one to four years.

The seedling for all the experiments took place in the month of September. The germination was quite satisfactory throughout, and the growth of the wheat in the autumn was good.

On the 15th of July, which was about six days earlier than in 1895, the trouble from frost was first observed. The wheat plants were not yet fully grown, and the frost was not so severe as in 1895.
