From a "Scientific" for the telephone
The Telephone Business has become one of the greatest businesses of the age. The annual report of the American Bell Telephone Company shows that the corporation increased last year 52,720 telephones, an increase of over 40,000 in one year. The company has 812 exchanges and a mileage of wire of 807,791, of which 90,418 miles are operated underground.

SERVICABLE TREE SUPPORT.
Round steel nail, and clinching just tightly enough that the laths may be opened or closed for storing a way. The name of using them is shown in the sketch sent by D. L. Yates. If the service will be hard, the lower end of the lath should be pointed. This arrangement, by being kept under shelter when not in use, will last for many years, and frequently saves enough fruit upon one tree to pay the purchase cost, and prevent an entire bundle of laths.

Support for Bushes and Trees.
Raspberry and other berry bearing bushes often set and mature more fruit than the stalks can support, and, consequently, are so loaded as to rest upon the ground, injuring the fruit if not occurring in fruit trees with spreading branches. This can be remedied by nailing together two strips of lath within an inch of one end, with a single six inches of one end, with a single
