Rennes, Sept. 8.—At the opening of the court-martial of Captain Dreyfus yesterday morning, Maitre Labié, leading counsel for the defence, announced that he had received a semi-official intimation that Colonel Schwartzkoppen, the former German military attaché at Paris, and Major Panizzardi, the former Italian military attaché at Paris, would be unable to appear personally before the court...
