Mr. H. B. Edwards is no Longer a Paid Official-Council Adopts the Fees System

Railway Notes.

The C.P.R. fast Imperial Limited train will be taken off on Oct. 15th. The Pacific and Atlantic express will make stops at all stations, and some of the local trains will be taken off.

The Russian government will need 700 locomotives for the Trans-Siberian railway, and is puzzled to know where it is going to get them. The American, English and continental works have orders ahead for almost two years.

The Rainy River Railway is being pushed with great vigor by McKenzie & Mann's contractors. Between 5,000 and 6,000 men are at work on a section 15 miles long, between Smith's Bay and the Port Arthur, Duluth & Western Railway, southwesterly towards Rainy River, and next spring 10,000 men will be engaged in order to try and complete the road to secure a share of next year's north-west harvest.

The Klondike Nugget of September 11th gives the following prices: Flour, \$5 to \$6 a sack; sugar, 18c a pound; bacon, 25c to 30c; rolled oats, 20c to 25c; potatoes, 25c to 75c a pound; milk, 40c to 50c a can; canned meats, 50c to 75c a can; ham, 35c to 40c a pound; cabbage, 10c; cucumbers, three for 1¢; tomatoes, 75c a pound; live chickens, \$3 each; beefsteak, mutton, pork or veal, 60c to \$1 a pound. The local prices are: Bacon, 25c; ham and coffee, 25c; steak and eggs and coffee, 75c.

Where They Make Money.

A western Ontario farmer who has just returned from a trip from Manitoba, has been giving his experience to the Weekly Sun: "It is simply marvellous," he says, "how people were getting on in that country. Seven years ago, when I first went to the west, I moved to the vicinity of Oak River, Manitoba. When he reached that country he had only enough money to buy a yoke of oxen and carry him through the first year. He now has two sections of land, consisting of 640 acres each. He has 400 acres in grain crop this year, and at least 400 of that is wheat. You can't find a better place in Ontario than there is on his farm. He has, besides, 18 good work horses. He should have at least 10,000 bushels of wheat this year, which he will sell from between 50 cents to 70 cents per bushel, and the total cost of raising the same will be only 20 cents per bushel. All told, he does not owe over \$500."
