Butter Making.

Editor of THE EXPOSITOR: DEAR SIR,-The following are some of the principles necessary for good butter-making. Milk contains more or less sugar in chemical form, therefore much heat causes it to change, as if turning into vinegar, similar to maple sap. This vine-gar nature eats away much of the fatty substance that forms butter. In such a case the butter formed is of a whitish dry appearance; half butter and half curds or cheese. There should be an extra set of dishes to hold one milking, so that the dishes used are perfectly clean (boiling or scalding water is necessary,) and aired for some ten hours before they are used, as the last sourness in the dishes acts as a leaven to change the milk. There are also necessary a clean, cool milk room, ocacts contrary to vinegar or sourness, clean milking, clean surroundings in general, pure air, sweet breath, as bad breath vitiates the air. One of the great essentials is "Cleanliness: virtue next to godliness, Easiest, needfullest, cheapest duty, For the body, health and beauty, Who in the world would refuse it

When a little water does it." Clean pastures for cattle, not open for hogs to roam over, and sheep's breath is said to kill serpents, or as being of a poisonous nature. Clean water is most essential for cattle, plenty of good neurishing food, and not to drive them fast. If the foregoing rules were generally followed, with other particulars consistent therewith, bad butter would be a scarce article. A. FARMER.




