A STRONG RESERVE FUND.

Feature of the Report of the British America Assurance Co.

A most satisfactory feature of the annual report of the British America Assurance Company, which appears in another column, is the substantial addition to the reserve fund of \$90,819.21, which brings that fund to the very large figure of \$702,921.17. The report shows, too, that the balance of income over expenditure was \$173,713.63, which paid two half-yearly dividends at the rate of 6 per cent., allowed for the writing off of the company's premises and securities amounting to \$22,894.42, and permitted the large increase to the reserve fund mentioned. The estimated liability on policies current at the close of the year is \$662,312.77, an amount ample to meet the various risks. In moving the adoption of the report reference was made by the President, Hon. George A. Cox, to the future, which he considered sufficiently encouraging to warrant shareholders in anticipating equally favorable results in the coming year as they had experienced during the past. It is interesting to note that the report presented was the 69th annual report, a testimony to the strength and stability of the company.
