How to Serve Creamed Beef. This is a delicious breakfast dish and very easily prepared. For a breakfast for four use a half pound of smoked beef chipped very fine. Put a heaping tablespoonful of butter in a saucepan and let it come to a bubble over a slow fire. Then add a heaping tablespoonful of sifted flour. Stir flour and butter till they are of the consistency of cream; add a pint of almost boiling milk. Stir the mixture constantly to keep the flour from lumping When the sauce boils drop the chipped beef into it and let it boil for two minutes. Serv at once.


