Blessed for above the sky.

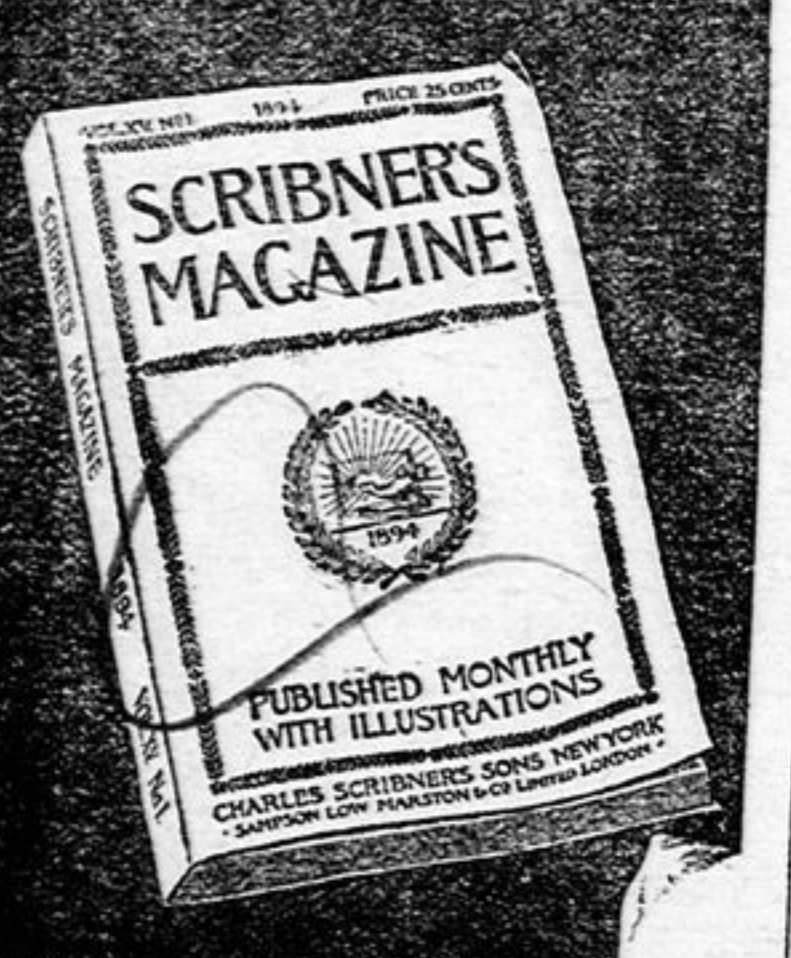
Forever let the heavens ring,
