**WARSAW.**

The successful Results of using the Bala-  
cock Tester.

The annual meeting of the Warsaw cheese  
factory was held in the factory on Saturday,  
Nov. 25th. There was a good attendance  
of patrons, and much interest was taken in  
the meeting. Mr. Warren Taylor presided,  
and Mr. S. R. Payne, secretary, presented  
his report as follows. It is worthy of a per-  
usal:—

The business of the Warminster cheese

Lbs. milk for 1 lb. cheese in 1892... 10.92  
Price per 100 lbs milk..... 90 1/4

It may be of interest to some to study the  
following, which is the result of 23 cows for  
six months, or during one season: 108,308  
lbs. of milk, which is a little over 1 1/2 stand-  
ards per cow. These cows are carefully  
managed. Also the result of 12 cows for  
a similar period, 22,200 lbs. of milk, which  
is a little over 3/4 standards per cow, and  
shows plainly the results of care and feed.  
We will examine into it just a little and see  
how different will be the profit per cow.

In the first case a cow gave 47 cwt. @  
90.14c. per cwt. = \$42.36; in the second case  
a cow gave 13.5c. @ 90.14 = \$16.67, or a  
very sad difference of \$25.69. This would  
buy considerable chop, or pay for a good  
many dairy papers, and also pay for a little  
time to read them besides. Some say ex-  
perience is an expensive teacher. I may say  
ignorance of the principles of one's business  
is an extremely expensive companion, and  
still the very men who are needing light  
most are impossible to reach. They will  
attend no meeting nor convention, and read  
no paper. You will likely see them at a  
circus and a "hard times" concert. They  
have such a profound reverence for their  
forefathers that they don't mind paying a  
rent each year to their memory and wish  
continually for bygone days to return.  
They don't enjoy reforms by Lombast  
nor by the Balacock test either.
