

Cavan Township Council Meeting

Millbrook, Jan. 14, 1957.—The inaugural meeting of Cavan Council was held on above date in the Council Chamber, Millbrook, at 11 a.m.

The Clerk first administered the oath of office to the Reeve, then the Deputy-Reeve and then the Councillors. After subscribing to the oath of office, the following members took their seats, that is to say: Reeve—Lloyd A. Hooton. Deputy-Reeve—John H. McKnight.

Councillors—Donald Cathcart, Harold Bradburn, George Howden.

Rev. A. E. Larke of Springville United Church, offered the opening prayer, and invocation for divine guidance during the coming year.

The Reeve in his opening address thanked Rev. Mr. Larke for being with us, also for the kind words of advice given this Council for 1957. He congratulated the Deputy Reeve on being returned to his office by acclamation, also the three Councillors on being returned to their offices for another term. He asked for the cooperation of all the members, as he had in the past. He made mention of our new Municipal Garage which we had built last year, and also had paid for same. We also had been able to get through another year without borrowing any money. He felt they had a very efficient staff in the Clerk-Treasurer, Collector of Rates, Assessor, Road Supt. and Operator. He made mention of work which was needed to be done in the Town Hall, and felt they start same early in the year.

The Deputy Reeve congratulated the Reeve by being returned to the office of Reeve for the fourth term by acclamation, also the Councillors on all being returned for another term. He felt they had a good year last year, although they had not been able to do as much on the roads as the year before on account of being cut on their road appropriation, but hoped they would be given more this year. He hoped they would all work together as they had in the past for the best interest of the ratepayer.

Councillors Cathcart, Bradburn and Howden, Road Supt. Assessor and Clerk all made brief remarks, and as our Reeve was aspiring for the Wardenship of the United Counties of Northumberland and Durham on the following day, they all wished him success, and was sure he would be elected.

On motion of Deputy Reeve McKnight-Councillor Howden, that we adjourn to 1.15 p.m. Council Resumed at 1.15 p.m.

Deputy-Reeve J. H. McKnight in the Chair, as the Reeve was detained for awhile.

Mr. R. Cathcart addressed the Council re his account for rental of a piece of land which grader had been parked on at different times, and asked if same would be paid that day.

The Deputy-Reeve explained to him it would come up when the accounts were presented and would be dealt with then.

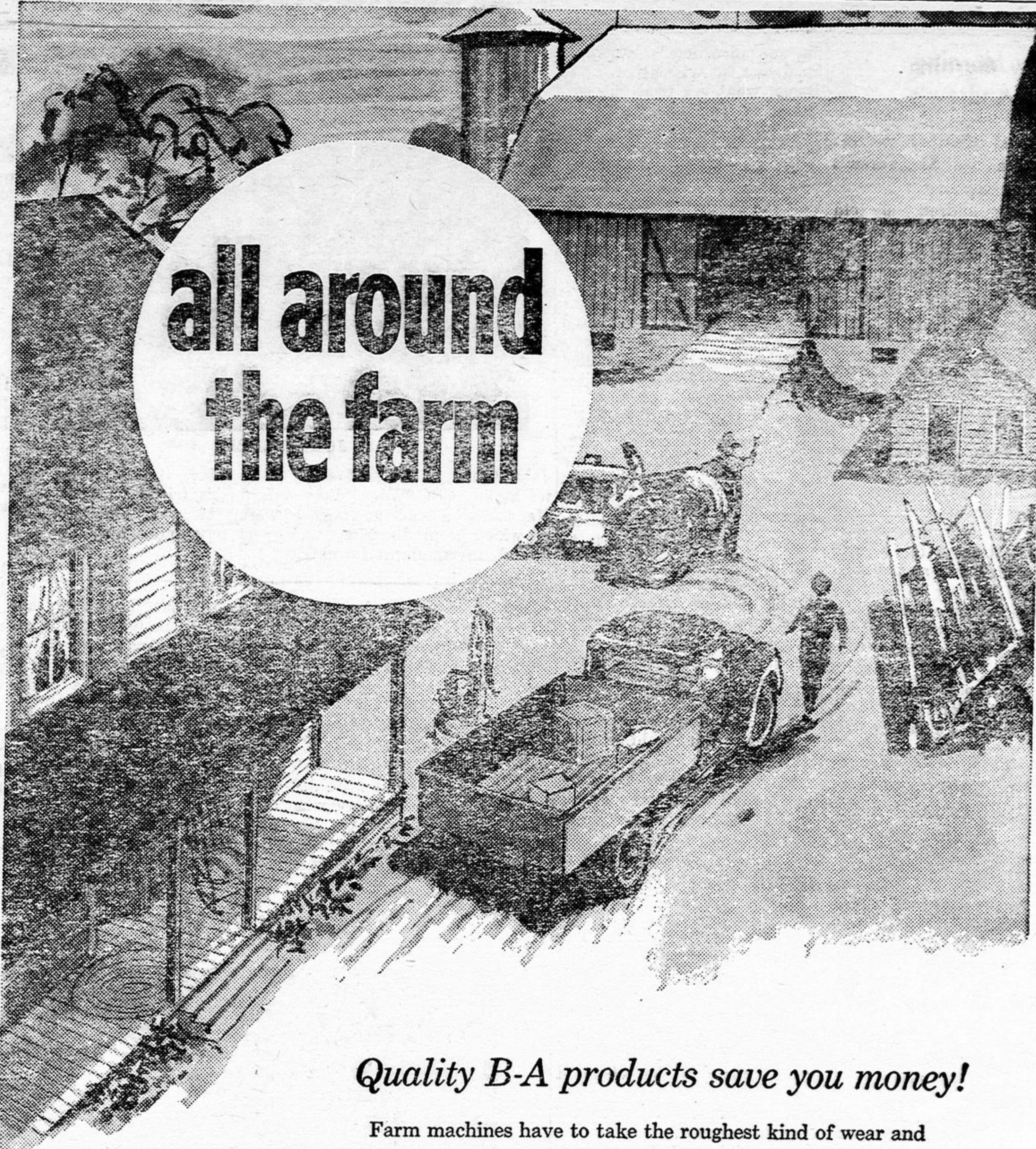
