Harry Kennedy Loses Barn Loss Heavy

A barn fire with a loss estimated in the neighbourhood of \$30,000, belonging to Harry Kennedy on the 10th Concession of Cavan, occurred early Friday morning. Mr. and Mrs. Kennedy were successful in releasing 19 dairy cows from the burning large L-shaped barn, 120 x 30 feet and 60 x 40 feet. A tractor was also saved with the help of neighbours and the aid of a car for power.

However, the Kennedys lost in the blaze, five registered Holstein heifers, over 170 tons of hay and straw, 1500 bushels of grain, a hammer-mill, milk cooler and milking machinery.

It is not known how the fire started, but could have been spontaneous combustion. The wind was blowing from the Northwest and fortunately away from the house, otherwise it too would likely have been ruined.

Neighbours rallied to the aid of Mr. and Mrs. Kennedy in the way of work and donations of feed for the surviving cattle, for which Mr. and Mrs. Kennedy wish to express their sincere thanks.

W. KINSMAN, W. MORTON AND BYRON FALLIS HURT IN PETERBOROUGH

The above three well known Millbrook men were injured in Peterborough on Monday when a truck driven by Mr. Fallis was in collision with a CNR freight train at Perry and Aylmer Streets about 5.45 p.m. Fallis has forehead and facial lacerations; William Kinsman a lacerated forehead and fractured hip, and Wes Morton head cuts.

The three men were taken to Civic Hospital and all are in satisfactory condition.

Damage to the truck is in the neighbourhood of \$500.00.
