1 enevlope gelatine, 1/4 cup cold water. l cup boiling water,

1 teaspoon lemon juice, 1/4 cup of sugar,

1-3 cup frozen tangerine contrate, (1/2 lof a 6 oz. tin) 1 egg white.

Soak gelatine in the cold water. Add boiling water, sugar, lemon juice and tangerine juice. Stir thoroughly, cool in fridge till as thick as unbeaten egg whites, then beat till frothy and light in colour. Beat egg white till it stands in peaks, mix in tangerine mixture gently. Plour into a 1 quart mould or 6 dessert dishes.
