The Executive of the Durham County Liberal Association met at the Community Hall in New-castle on April 25th, 1958, for the purpose of hearing reports from delegates to the Liberal Leadership Convention held in Toronto on April 18th-19th.

The meeting was under the chairmanship of Mr. Robert Kent of Bowmanville, President of the Association.

Reports were heard from the delegates, Messrs. Frank Rickard, R. E. Lovekin, E. A. Woodyard, Gordon Trick and Russell Honey.

A Nominating Committee was elected under the chairmanship of Mr. Elmore Scott to make arrangements for a Nominating Convention to be held for purpose of nominating a candidate to contest the Provincial election, expected to be called this autumn. Members of the Committee are Frank Rickard and George Walton of New-castle; Ivan Hobbs and John James of Bowmanville; B. H. Hutton and Russell Honey of Port Hope; Gordon Trick of Millbrook, James Castle of Darlington, Laverne Chapman of Manvers, Eric Fallis of Cavan, Harry Wade of Clarke, David Ford of Hope and Neil Malcolm of Cartwright.

It was generally predicted that the Nominating Convention would be held about the middle of June. It was decided to hold the Convention in New-castle Community Hall. Several strong candidates are in evidence as enthusiasm for the cause of Liberalism in Ontario is running high, following the election of Kitchener lawyer, John J. Wintermeyer as leader of the Ontario Liberal Party.
