

### Manvers Township Council

Bethany, Ont., June 2, 1959. —The regular monthly meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Manvers was held on the above date with all members present and the Reeve Presided.

The minutes of the May meeting were read and approved on motion of Malcolm and Brown.

The following communications were received and read: The report of the Warble Fly Inspectors. An offer of purchase from the Dept. of Highways for frontage off Municipal Garage lot for Highway purposes. The Consultative Committee of the United Counties requesting a meeting with the Council re High School matters. Dept. of Highways approval of the 1959 road expenditures. Attorney General's Dept. re new school for police. 1959 levy from the United Counties amounting to \$23,546.70 due Dec. 5th, 1959. Several sheep claims and one school requisition.

On motion of Malcolm and Jakeman, the Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillor Brown were appointed as a Committee to negotiate with Dept. of Highways re settlement of amount of compensation for frontage off Municipal Garage lot. Carried.

The Building Inspector interviewed the Council re the matter of issuing a building permit. After referring to the Building By-Law it was discovered that the application did not comply with the requirements of the By-Law and thus the application would have to be rejected.

Moved by Jakeman, seconded by Malcolm that the application for building permit as submitted by the Building Inspector be rejected as it was non-conforming with the Building By-Law. Carried.
