Mr. and Mrs. Ogden will live on their farm at Newtonville.

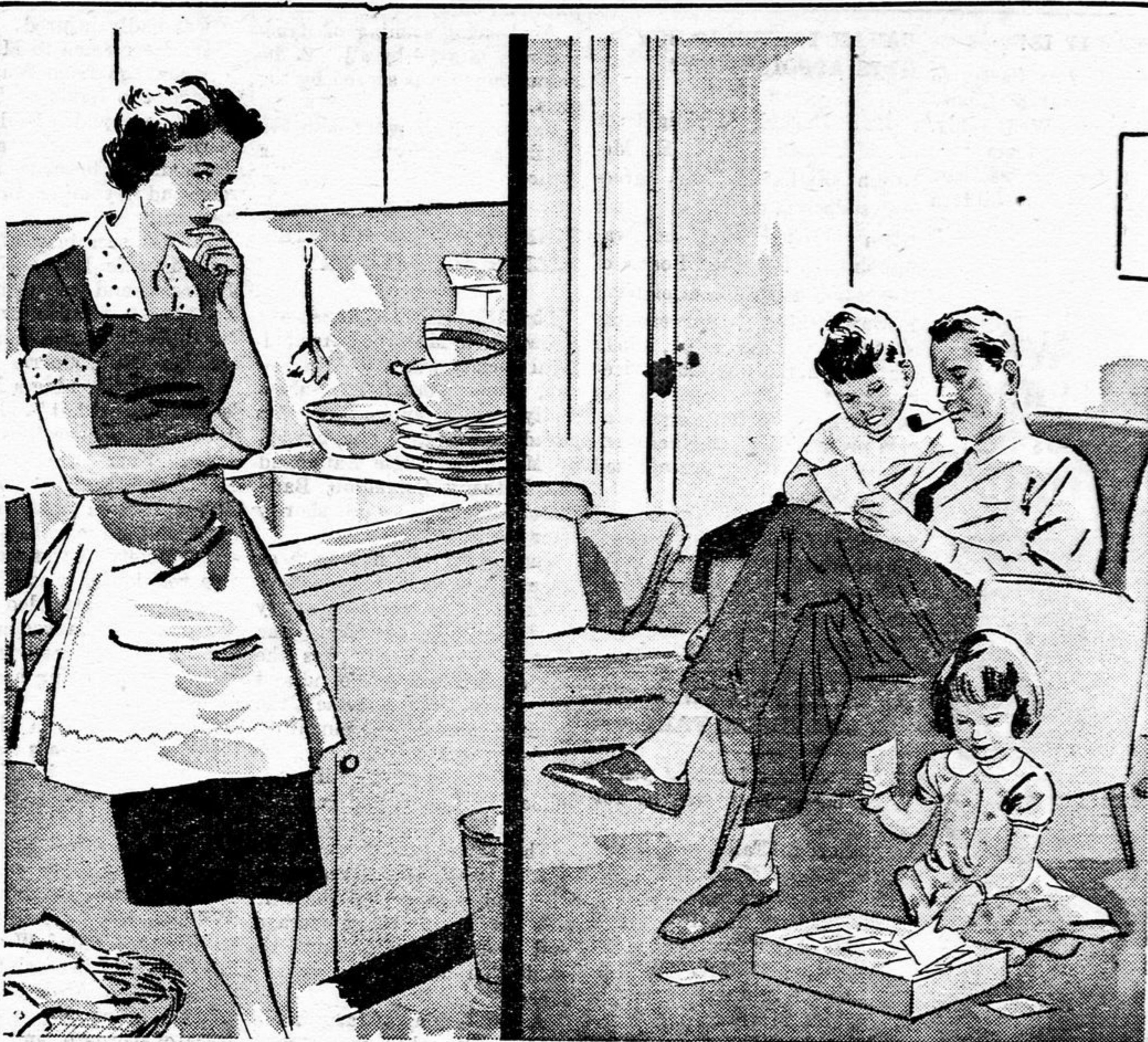

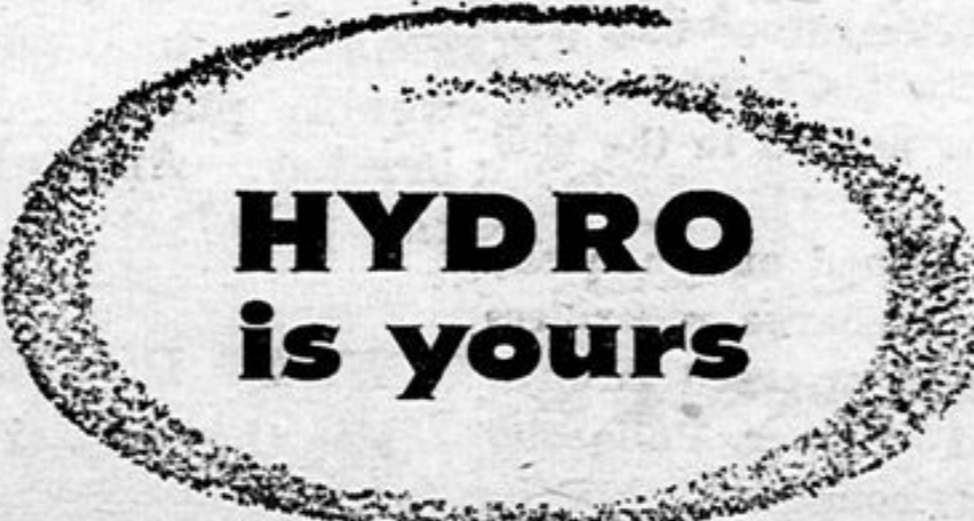
