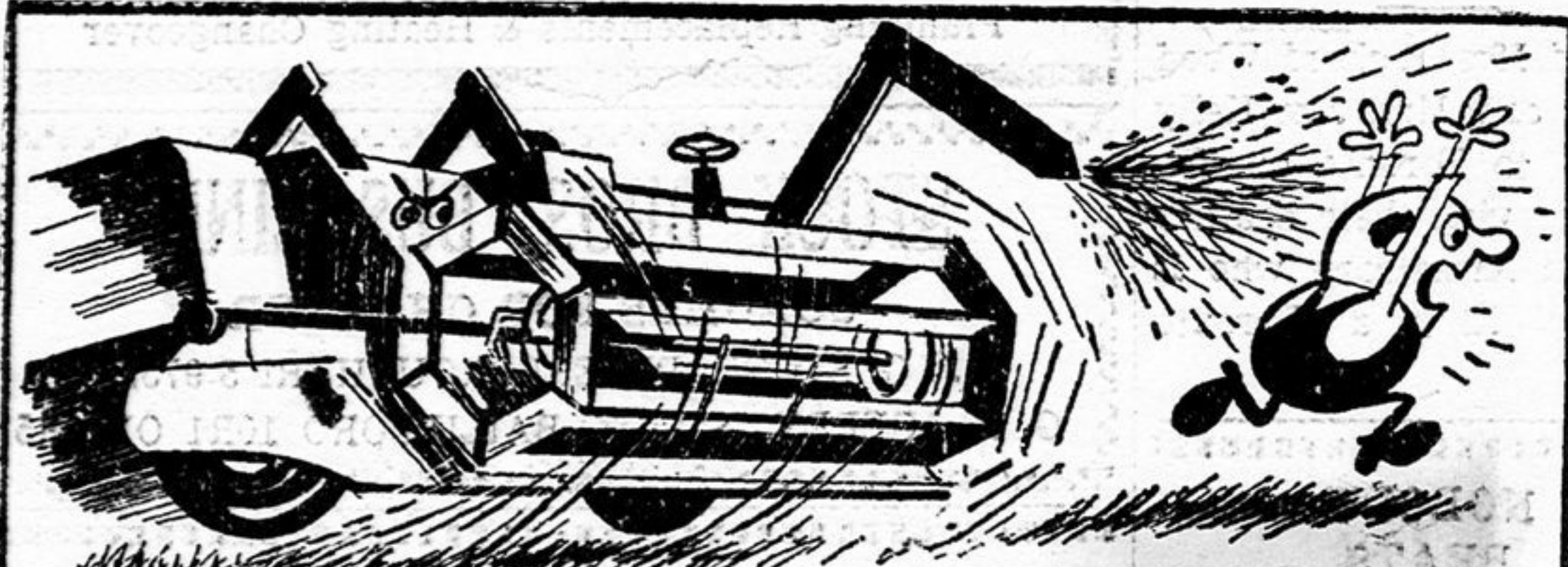

## HOG CHOLERA WARNING

Farmers in Durham County should watch their swine herds for any signs of sickness and in the event of any unusual conditions contact their local veterinarian, stated A.O. Dairymple, Agricultural Representative, Ontario Department of Agriculture, Bowmanville.

He stated that a news report from the Canada Department of Agriculture pointed out that Hog Cholera is prevalent in Eastern Ontario and Western Quebec with 1100 hogs having been slaughtered on three premises.

Local Health of Animals Veterinarians for the Canada Department of Agriculture in Bowmanville stated that hogs have passed through sales barns in the general area from known infected premises in Eastern Ontario and Quebec. Although there is no Hog Cholera known at the present in this area, at least three herds are undergoing quarantine in Durham County because of the possibility swine in those herds may have been in contact with infected hogs.

It has been suggested that farmers avoid buying hogs if possible for at least the next thirty days. If you are purchasing hogs, buy from known local farmers who have raised the hogs on their own premises, and who have not had swine brought on the premises recently. It is interesting to note that in the last serious outbreak of Hog Cholera in 1960-61 more than 57,000 hogs had to be ordered slaughtered. Compensation to owners amounted to \$1,750,000. Where it is necessary to carry out a slaughter program, the swine owner is paid on a market value basis. It is suggested that all swine owners prohibit anyone looking after swine and that they likewise stay away from all breeders. Market hogs will continue to be sold in Ontario through Hog Producers Assembly Yards on the understanding the hogs are consigned to slaughtering establishments operating under federal meat inspection. In conclusion, it is suggested that swine breeders carry on their operations in the normal manner, contacting their veterinarian in case of (Please see Page 4)
