It is interesting to note that in he last serious outbreak of Hog Cholera in 19-60-61 more than 57,000 hogs had to be ordered slaughter ed. Compensation to owners afounted to \$1,750,000. Whe re it is necessary to carry out a slaughter program, the swine owner is paid on a market value basis.

It is suggested that all swine owners prohibit anyone looking after swine and that they likewise stay awak from all breeders.
