On motion by Jay Whittington seconded by A. G. Anderson the Reeve and Clerk were authorized to sign the interim subsidy forms for the Dept. of Highways as soon as same are completed.

The following general accounts were presented by the Treasurer for consideration:

F. S. Coyle, refund of gravel tender deposit. 300.00  
Clerk's salary, July and stationery ..... 75.40

These accounts totalling \$441.50 were passed for payment on motion by Robt. Fisher seconded by Jay Whittington.

The following correspondence had been received by the Clerk and were presented as follows:

George Totten, County Road Engineer advising that total estimated cost of the new bridge will be \$5,850.00 and suggested Council pass a supplementary by-law in the amount of \$1,850. to cover this over-expenditure; in this respect Council decided to contact the Dept. of Highways for consultation on the matter.

Village of Millbrook advising Mrs. Irene Willan is an indigent patient at Fairweather Nursing Home and therefore South Monaghan will be responsible for twenty per cent. of the cost, the remaining eighty per cent will be paid by the Province of Ontario. Council accepted this responsibility.

Ontario Department of Transport advising of regulations concerning size and description of stop signs.
