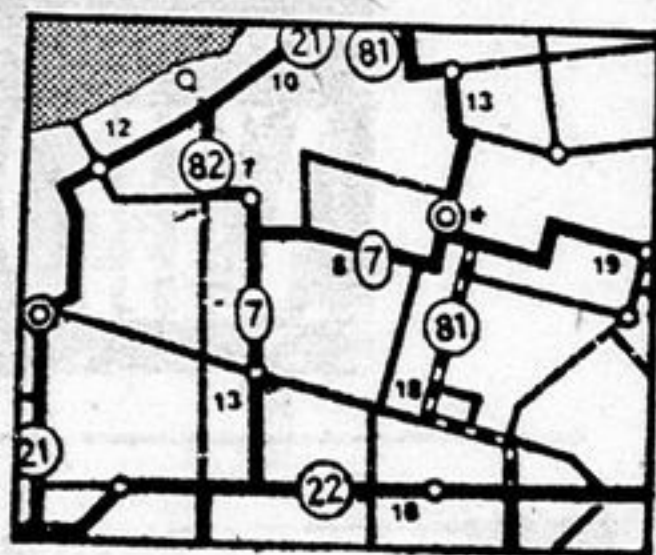

School cont'd

Bowmanville replacing Mr. Witherspoon. Mr. L. G. Johnston as Acting Head of a new Industrial Arts Dept. in Bowmanville.

Night Schools were approved for Bowmanville and Port Hope. Advertisements will appear in local papers.

At a meeting called by Bowmanville Council, 6 of 8 Councils agreed to approve formal resolutions for issue of debentures for a 500 - 700 school in Darlington and a 150 school in Millbrook.

The Board passed unanimously a motion calling for the building of a 500 pupil school at Cortice and a 150 pupil school in Millbrook. The estimated cost to be \$700,000 for the Courtice school and \$110,000 for the Millbrook school. The appropriate resolutions were mailed to the Councils October 1st.

The next Board meeting will be in Millbrook, Wednesday, October 21st.

RE TOBACCO

Flue-cured tobacco growers have also started a considerable amount of soil fumigation. Nematodes damage the roots of tobacco, thereby decreasing the yield and allowing Brown Root-Rot to develop which further decreases the yield. Tobacco growers have realized returns of \$3 to \$5 per dollar invested in soil fumigation. With the yield increase, resulting from the use of D-D Soil Fumigant, on tobacco soil, it is expected that soil fumigation will become standard practice in several thousand acres of tobacco soil each year.

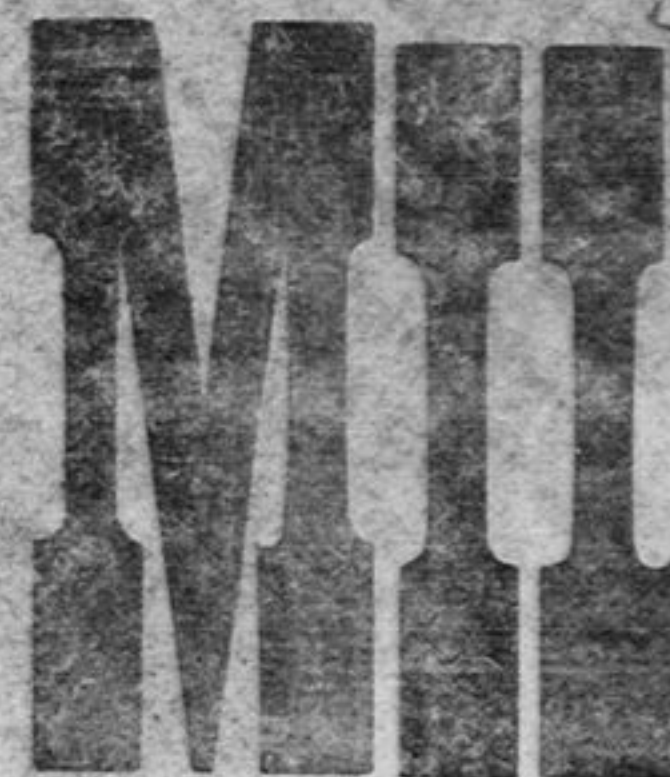
