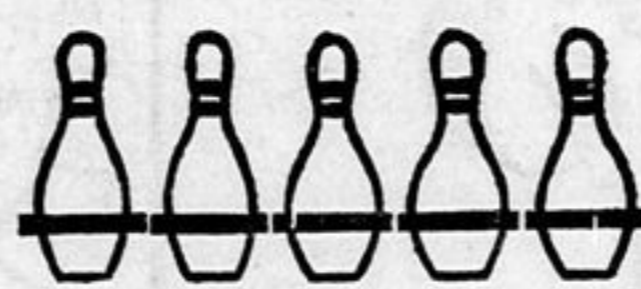

When you pick up the ball, keep your finger and thumb to the sides of the rack. If you allow them to slip between two balls, another ball sailing down the return rack can give them a nasty crack.

Regulation balls are five inches in diameter, and weigh three pounds eight ounces. Many lanes have some balls which may be a quarter of an inch smaller and several ounces lighter. If a smaller ball seems more comfortable in your hand, use it. But, once you have chosen the size of ball, stick to it. Changing the size of ball can throw your game right off.
