The element used is water, symbolic of spiritual cleansing for the adult, and of the entering into the blessing of the new covenant for the child, with the congregation taking responsibility for its share in the nurture and development of the child in Christian truth, and character.

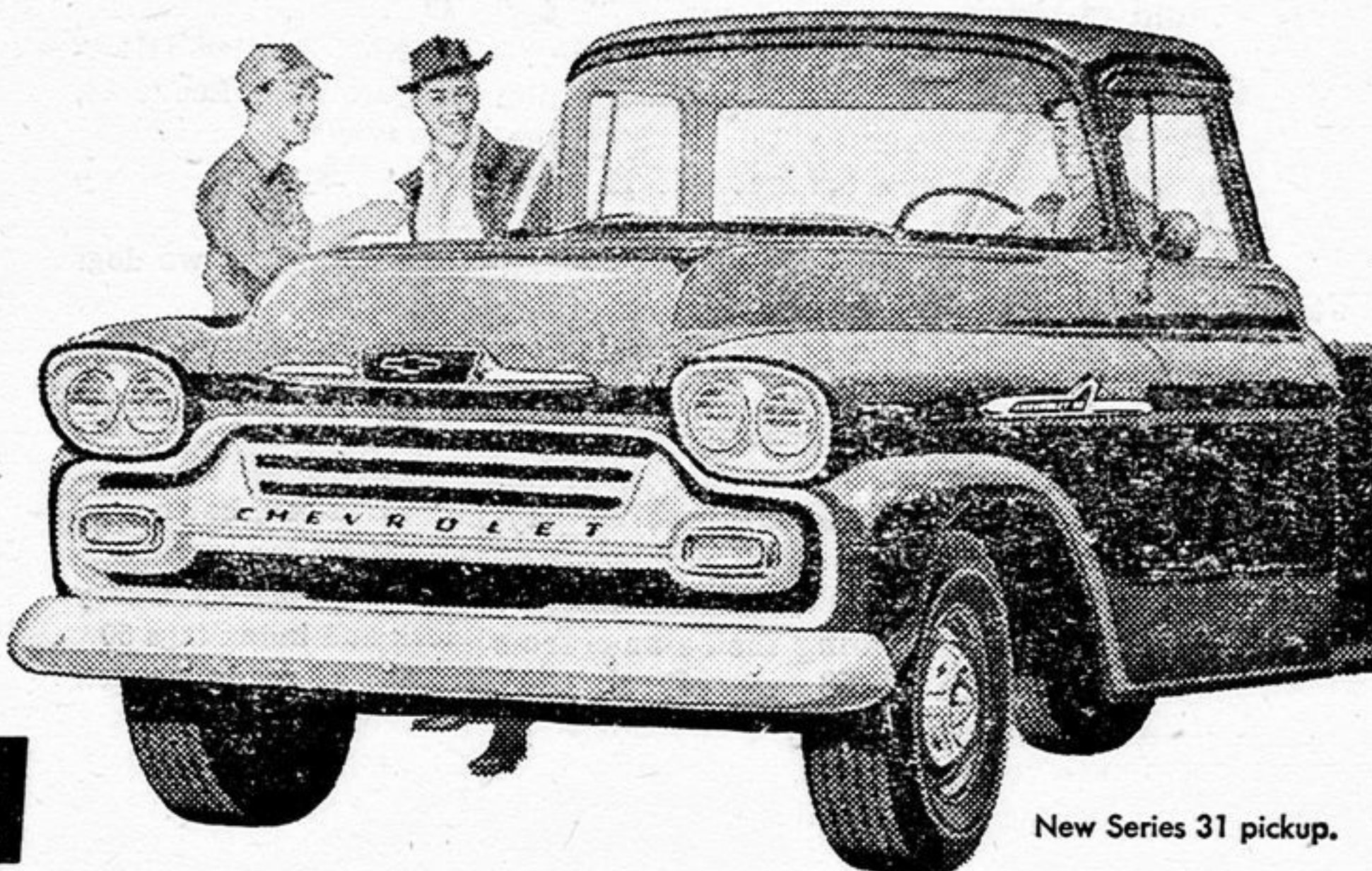

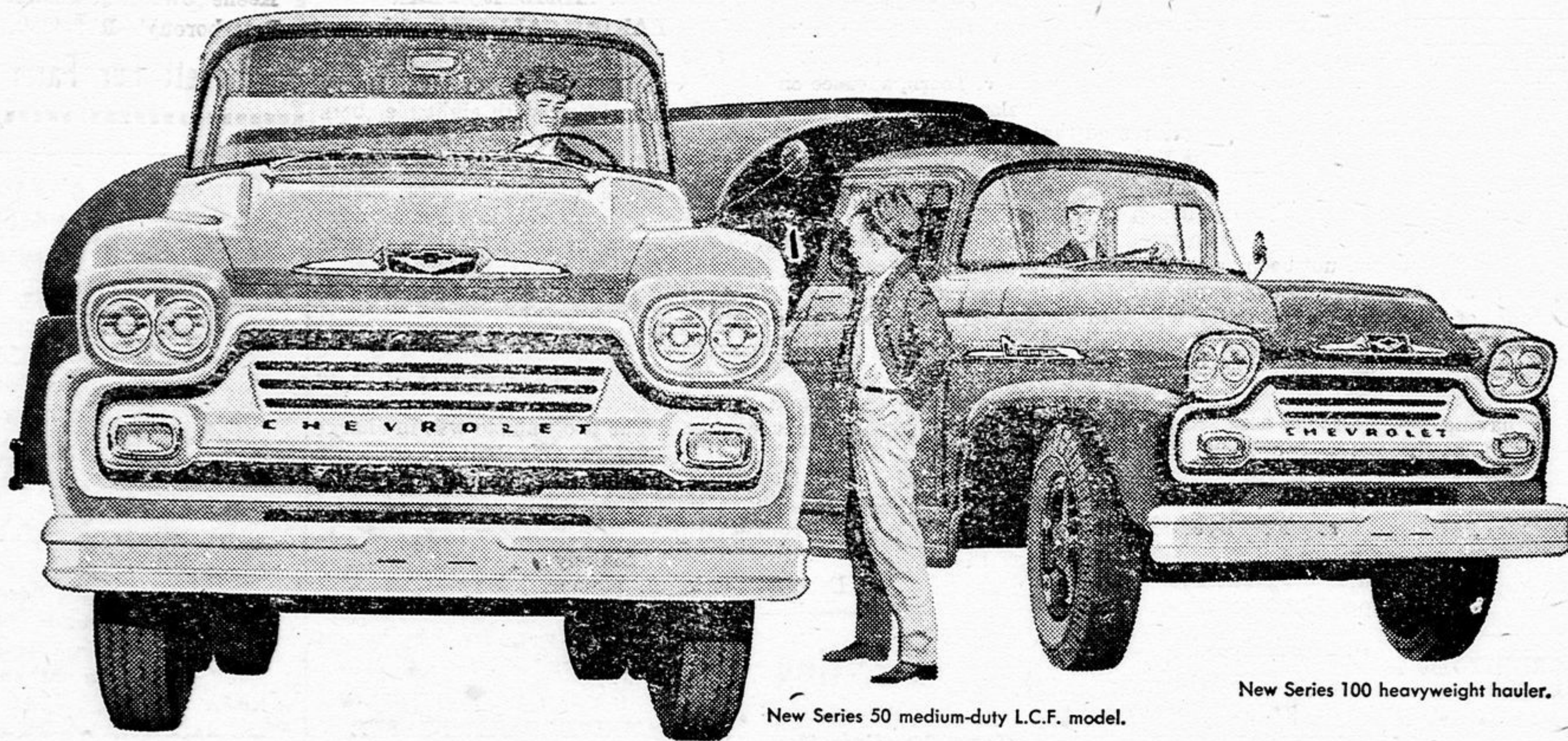
