NOTES OF INTEREST FROM HER BANKS AND BRAES.

What is going on in the Highlands and Lowlands of Auld Scotia.

The building trade was dull in Dumfriesshire last year. Rosyth is to have a gunpowder factory in its neighborhood. The customs revenue at Leith last year amounted to £1,267,374. There were 135 cases disposed of in Perth Sheriff Court last year.

Hamilton coalfield is stated to be showing signs of exhaustion. Farmers in Portwilliam district are complaining of sheep-worrying. Work has begun in erecting the new swing bridge at Rothsay.

Trade was very good in Greenock last year, especially in engineering. Last year 5,566 cases were tried in Dundee Police Court, an increase of 766.

The extension of Ayr Academy has now been completed at a cost of £7,702. Last year was a better one for spinners than for manufacturers in Dundee.

During the past year the population of Blythburgh parish went up nearly 500. The Marquis of Linlithgow is to allow his tenantry abatements from 25 to 50 per cent.

Mr. Waldane is to be asked to stand for re-election as Lord Rector of Edinburgh University. In Fraserburgh influenza is prevalent and several cases of typhoid fever have been notified.

The justices of the late Duke of Hamilton have given £137 for coal to the poor of the district. A hall erected at Denholm for the villagers by Captain Palmer Douglas was formally opened recently.

The members of the Hamilton Educational Institute are to celebrate their diamond jubilee in March. Coal and other gifts have been contributed to the poor on Hallyburton estate by Mr. W. D. Graham Menzies.

A fire occurred in the drapery warehouse of John Stirling & Son, Airth, the loss is estimated at £200. The loss in the Perthshire Society has been devoted to helping newly natives. Last year 786 persons were dealt with in Musselburgh Police Court, an increase over the previous year of 336.

John Fyfe, tinsmith, and David Charles Bennet, golf caddie, have got six months each for burglary at St. Andrews.

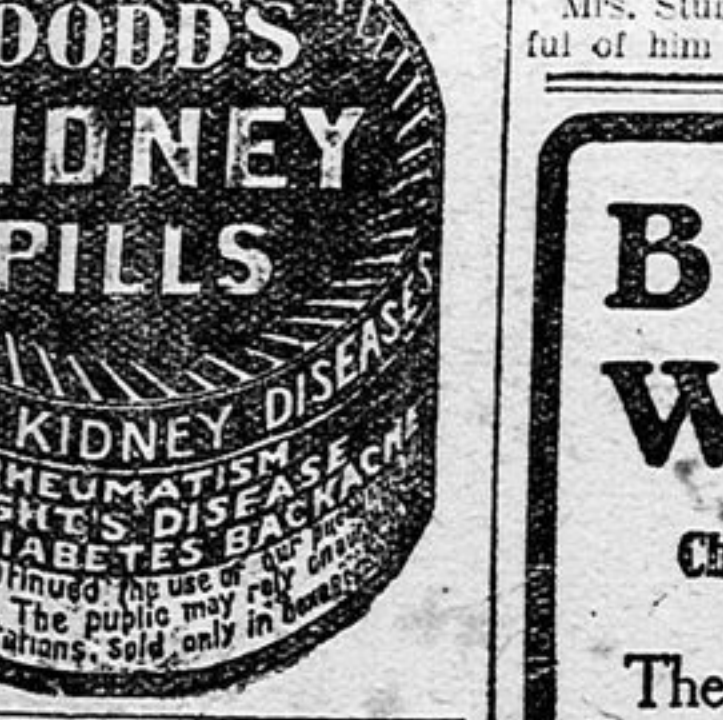
BRIGHTENING MONKEY LIVES.

Expensive Apes Provided With a Small Boy as Playmate to Keep Them Well.

The Zoological Gardens at Copenhagen have recently acquired two expensive apes, and to keep them in good spirits a small boy has been placed in the cage, whose sole duty is to play with the apes and keep them amused. The reason is explained by a zoological expert.
