**Victoria Day at Omemee.**

The celebration of Victoria Day in Omemee was accompanied by very hot weather, but the bright sunshine was a compensation. Everything was at its best in nature and the large crowd enjoyed themselves thoroughly.

The first annual five mile Marathon for the Omemee Challenge Cup donated by Col. Sam Hughes, M.P., was run in the forenoon, not less than twelve entries being made. The outsiders, all but one, dropped out at the first mile and the race was finished in the following order: 1st, Geo. C. Preston, Lindsay; 2nd, W. Lowes, Omemee; 3rd, H. Watson, Omemee; 4th, H. Magee, Omemee.

The runners were paced by Mr. J. C. Eaton, of Toronto, in his auto, and the course was along King St. The trophy is a silver cup to be run for by amateurs. The winner in three successive years gets the cup. In the afternoon a football game between Omemee and Bethany was won by the home team by 1-0. The game was followed by the land sports on the same grounds. The sack race was run in heats on account of the number of entries, the winners competing in a final. The jumping contest between W. McCaffrey, Toronto, and W. Lowes was close, and the record was 38 feet 10 inches.

After the land sports the crowd adjourned to the river, where a great deal of fun ensued over the aquatic sports.
