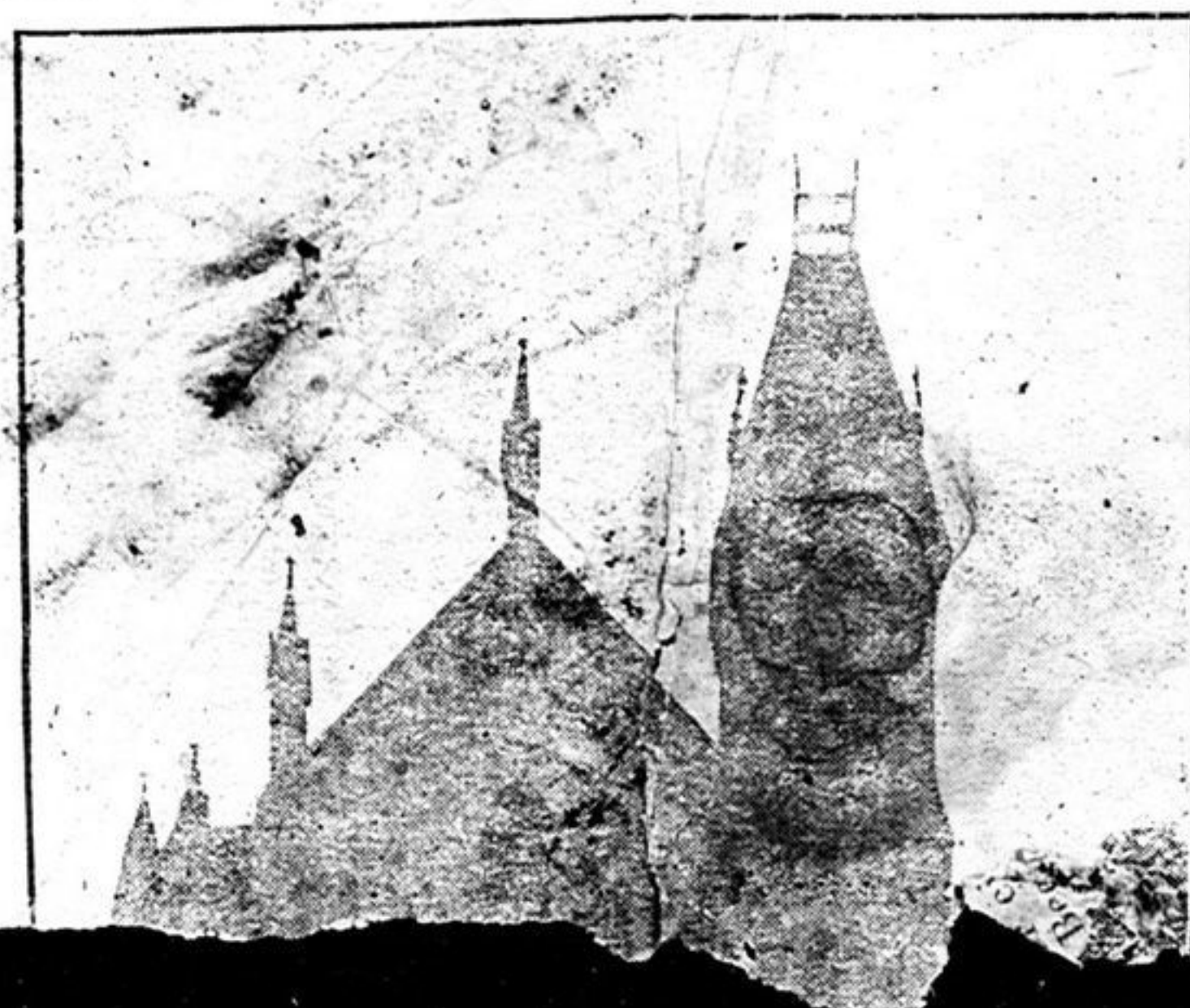

The electors of this good old County of Durham are going to benefit themselves by electing Mr. Simpson, the Government Candidate, on the 26th.
