THE MAYOR DISCREDITED.

We must say that the more we look into the vote at the Council on Monday night on the reduction of licenses, the less we like the look of it. We are given to understand by the committee who interviewed Mr. Begg before the election as to his stand on the question, that, whilst he said he would not vote for a reduction on account of his intimate relation with the hotels, that, on the other hand if a majority of the Council were in favor of a reduction, HE WOULD NOT OPPOSE IT. Heretofore Mr. Begg has been considered a man of his word and as having some backbone to him, but evidently, when pressure is applied, the "foone" wilts, and we have an exhiwition, such as we had on Monday night. Mr. Begg went out of his way and woted as Mayor-an unusual proceeding-in order that the motion might be negatived. He also called for a second vote, evidently determined to whip those inclined to flunk into line. If that is not opposing it, what is?

The worst feature about it, as it appears to us, is that the man ancupying the honorable position of Mayor of Lindsay, deliberately broke his word. What confidence can we have in his word in the future? If a man will deceive on one question, will he not on others? Some people seem to think there is a differmerce in the grade of morality when discussing the liquor question, but wa fail to med it. However, the temperance and church people who voted for Mr. Begg, knowing of his promise, and believing him to be a good man otherwise for the position, (and there are quite a few who did soy now know what to expect-a wide-open town. The whole probeedings were evidently cut and dried Seforehand by the Mayor. Only last evening Mayor Begg callted up The Post and took just to task for our briticism of his action, and said that if he had to deal with the matter again he would vote as he did, therefore we can but conclude he does not realize the sacredness of his word. It is true we are "after" Mayor Begg, not as a private citizen, but as Mayor of the best town is Canada, whose interests we wish to
