#### PURCHASING PUBLIC SUPPLIES.

This is a question that interests us all, and we are the people who pay the piper. It has given rise to more so-called scandal, than almost any other phase of public expenditure. We do not agree by any means that everything that is trought up in this way, whether done by Grit or Tory is wrong, because some people, especialy when on the opposite side, seem to have very hazy ideas about what profit people ought to make out of a government. We noticed that Mr. Borden, in discussing the matter the other day, was very much at sea as to the best way purchasing should be done. He cited the C. P. R'y as an example, but Sir Wilfrid Laurier showed in a few words that it would be Enpossible for any government to do things the same as a corporation, or a mercantile house. If the C. F. R'y see a snap in rails, or anything else they need, they buy it at once, without any fuss, but if the governmeat or any one for them were to attempt anything of that kind, it would give rise to any amount of scandal. It can be seen that any Government is handicapped in a measure, in the purchasing of supplies. With responsible government, it would be impressible to hand the work over to purchasing agents, as recommended by the Civil Service Commission. We must ever look to the minister of any department, and make him responsible for anything and everything that is done in that department. This is the genius of our form of government, and even if the price comes high, we doubt if anyone is willing to give over any responsibility to irresponsible parties. As long as the seller is not getting an exorbitant profit, we fail to see why fault should be found with them for making money out of the government. We have heard of people who have tealered for public works or supplies, and lost money, some of them have been ruined. Surely that is not right? It seems to us, that any people through its government should be willing, to at least see that those who serve them do rot do so at a loss. We have heard of purchasing agents for large railways, being 'taken in," and viritually "sold", and these men are supposed to be the cutest of their sex. We agree, that if there is col-Jusion between government and seller, to the detriment of the people, someone ought to suffer.
