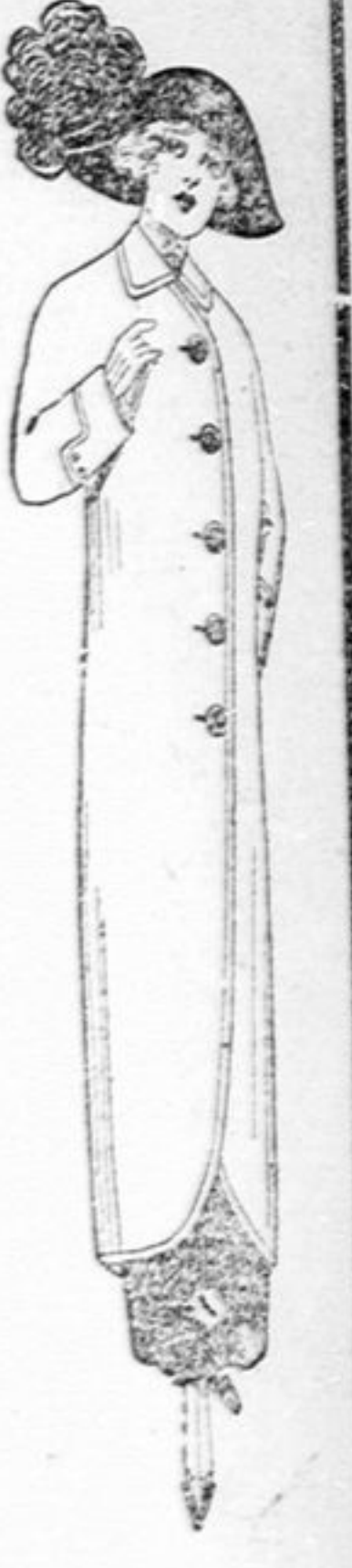
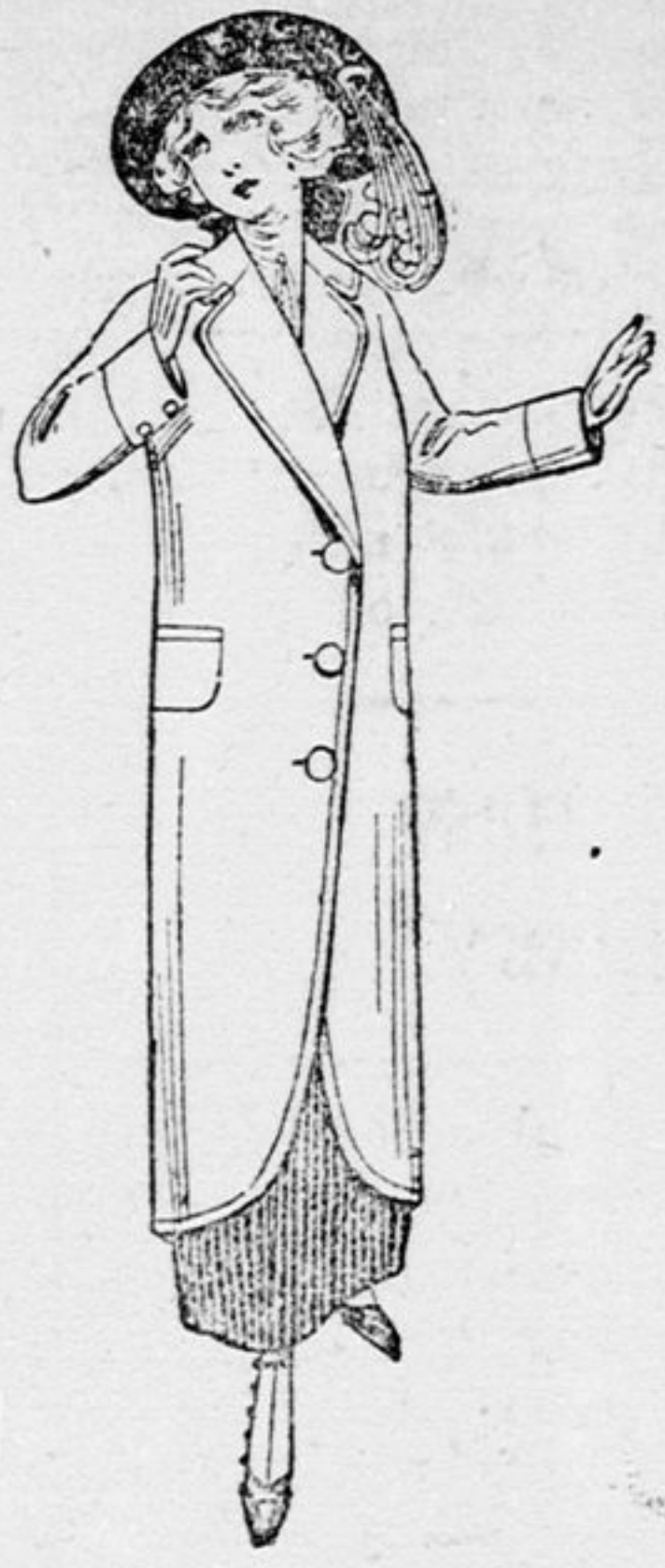
Fire Scare at Cameron Lake
