But it should be remembered that the Cross of St. Patrick, one of the most beautiful orders of Great Britain, is enamelled in ipale blue, the motto "Quis Separabit" being in gold letters on a ground of sky-bles enamel, the ribbon of the order, also being the shamrock, bearn an Imperial crown in gold, and the budge in pendant from an Irish harp. The collar is very beautiful consisting of six harps and live enamalled loses, echnected with gold knots.

The shamrock is universally worn in the hats all over Ireland on St. Patrick's Day. The popular notion is that when the sairt was preaching the doctrine of the Trinity he used this pant -three leaves on ane stem-to illustrate the great mys-

The reserence that still attaches to the shamrock is evidenced by the custom of the Irish people every March in sending over by mail or through friends, little boxes containing the beloved plant to their relatives in
