### Livestock at Union Stock Yards

Receipts of live stock at the Union stock yards, Toronto, were 74 cars, consisting of 1528 cattle, 172 sheep, 9 calves and 3 horses. The quality of fat cattle was fair, trade was better. Export prices ranged from \$4.15 to \$4.70, the bulk selling at \$4.30 to \$4.60. Export bulls sold at \$3.50 to \$4.25; butchers' prices for picked lots of choice ranged from \$4.40 to \$4.60, good from \$4.00 to \$4.25, medium \$3.75 to \$3.90, common \$3.25 to \$3.50. Butchers' cows \$2.50 to \$3.75, canners \$1.50 to \$2.00, feeders from \$3.40 to \$3.85, stockers from \$2.50 to \$3.00. Yearling calves sold at \$4.00 to \$6.00 per 100 lbs. Milch cows and springers at \$30 to \$50. Export ewes from \$4.50 to \$4.75, bucks \$3.00 to \$3.50, yearling lambs \$5, spring lambs \$5.75 to \$6. Hogs, select sold at \$8.40, light \$6.15, sows \$4 to \$5, stags \$2.50 to \$3.50 per 100 lbs.
