VICTORIA COUNTY COUNCIL

NOVEMBER SESSION.

Report of Finance and Assessment Committee.

On motion of Mr. Switzer, seconded by Mr. Cameron, the report of the standing committee on finance and assessment was received, read and adopted without amendment, as follows:

Your committee have duly considered the paragraphs of the Warden's address referred to them, and the documents bearing upon the subjects therein, and beg to recommend as follows:

1. That appreciation be expressed of the difficulty which was experienced in dealing with the cases of indigents.

2. That the arrangements made for the care of Thomas Winter be approved, the amount paid, owing to the exceptional trouble in attending the man, being \$16 per month.

3. That the Warden was justified in sending the man, Frederick Comfort, to the General Hospital, Toronto, for treatment that is likely to result in the restoration of sight.

4. That the old woman, Mrs. Eliza Potter, be continued in the Home for the Aged, and that the treasurer make a check on the county of Haliburton for the amount expended for her maintenance.

5. That the action of the Warden in attending the annual meeting of the Trent Valley Association at Peterborough, be approved. In this connection, a satisfactory statement of the financial transactions of the Association has been submitted.

6. That no change be made affecting the authority for the payment of fees to the Sheriff of the county for certain services in connection with the sittings of the court.

7. That gratification be expressed with the manner in which the Warden represented the council in relation to the Canadian Contingent for South Africa, and with the readiness shown by so many of the county's stalwarts to submit themselves to all the trials and dangers of stern warfare for the sake of the Empire.

Your committee have examined the report of the Registry Office committee, which was referred to them, and are gratified to find so much progress has been made in the settlement of the county's affairs in question. Your committee recommend that the report be re-introduced to the council.

Your committee have examined the resolutions of council submitted to them, and beg to recommend as follows:

1. With regard to the important resolution, the consideration of which was deferred from the June session, it is realized how satisfactory are the conditions that exist as to the application of the principles of taxation, especially in relation to the property of the great companies holding franchises that affect the whole body of the people. A draft of a petition transmitted to the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry, on the same subject, has also been considered, and in view of the fact that co-operation, on the grounds set forth in the petition, is already being asked from all the county councils in the province, it is desirable that the council should, for the sake of unity of effort, give expression to their views in similar terms.

2. That it is inexpedient to provide for the allowance of a rebate to such municipalities as may pay this county rate early in the month of December. The discussion of the question made clear the fact that it is the duty of the local treasurer to pay over to the county treasurer the amount of the county rate within fourteen days after the receipt of the same from the collector, without reference to the length of time prior to the first day of February at which it had been received by the local treasurer. The latest date for the payment of the county rate is the fifteenth day of February in the year succeeding the year in which the rate was levied, but the payment of the county rate can be deferred until the fifteenth day of February only in the event of the local treasurer not having received the money from the collector before the first day of February.

3. That the question of building a House of Refuge be deferred for further consideration.

4. That the expense of sending the Volunteers of the Canadian Contingent for South Africa to Kingston, amounting to \$62.90, be granted of twenty-five pounds to Lieut. Col. Sam. Hughes, M.P., and the gratuity of five pounds to Sgt. John McGee, be assumed and paid by the county.

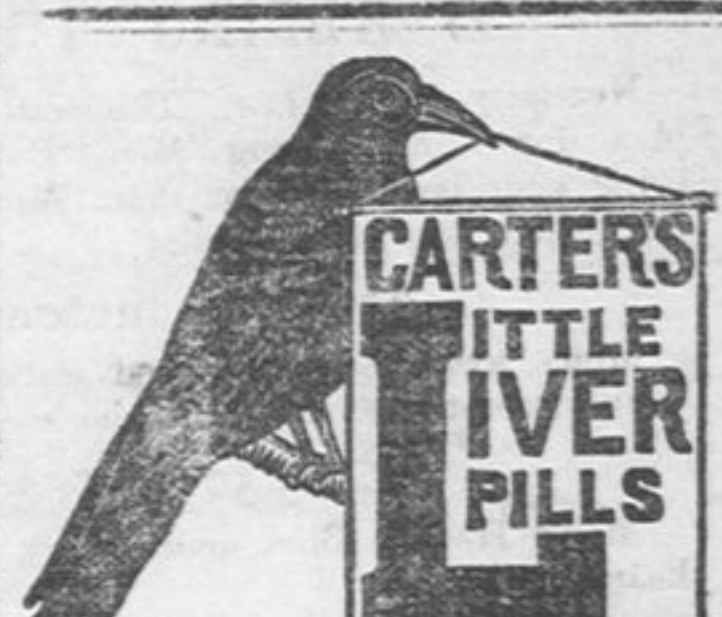

Your committee recommend that the treasurer's statement of receipts and payments for the period ending Oct. 31st be appended to this report, and that the statements of the Manager of the Bank of Montreal, of the balance standing at the credit of the treasury on the 30th day of June and 30th day of September, be filed.

Your committee have considered the communications and other documents referred to them, and beg to recommend as follows:

1. That the explanation of Messrs. Hogg Bros., relative to an alleged infraction of the provisions of the by-law respecting pedlars, be accepted as satisfactory.

2. That the draft of a memorial to the Lieutenant-Governor of the province, on the subject of reforming the treatment of inmates, transmitted by the secretary of the Prisoners' Aid Association, be introduced to the council.

3. That the communication from the clerk of the county of Grey, respecting a county roads system, be filed.

4. That the explanation of the secretary of the Oakwood Public Library, respecting certain payments, be accepted as satisfactory.

5. That the council do not undertake to pay a fee for the examination of indigent persons confined in the county jail, as requested by his honor Judge Harding.

6. That the reports of the Lindsay and Kirkfield Public Libraries, and of the Children's Aid Society, be filed.

Your committee have considered the petition of W. J. Chipman and others for a grant of money for the building of a lock-up at the village of Victoria Road, and beg to recommend that further consideration be deferred until the January session.

Your committee are gratified to learn that the Brandon lot in Verulam, which represented the last security held on account of the Railway sinking fund, has been sold.

The amount received was \$125 from which there is to be deducted: Costs, \$33.77; taxes, \$31.18; other expenses, \$11.05, leaving a net balance of \$50. Your committee recommend that the balance be distributed to the municipalities which formed the Railway group, in proportion to the amount of their contribution to the sinking fund.
