The attention of parties receiving these lists is respectfully directed to Sec. 12, Chap. 6 of the Ontario Voters' List Act, R. S. O., 1914.

(1) "The Sheriff shall immediately upon the receipt of his copies, cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in the Court House. The Clerk of the Peace, upon the receipt of his copies, shall cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in his office; every Head Teacher of a Public or Separate School shall post up one copy on the door of the School House; and every Postmaster shall post up one copy in his Post Office." 7 Edw. VII.

(2) "Where copies of the list have been sent to the Secretary or Secretary-Treasurer of a School Board instead of to the Head Teacher of a Public or Separate School, such Secretary or Secretary-Treasurer shall act in place of the Head Teacher, and shall post up one copy of the list on the door of every school house under control of the Board." 2 Geo. V., c. 4, s. 2.
