"However, our staff are not taking anything for granted. We remain focused on implementing precautionary measures and are diligently maintaining all new and ongoing care directives from the province," she continued.

Public health will be retesting all residents this week for clearance of the virus. Carr commends public health for proactively retesting residents who have been free of symptoms for at least 14 days looks forward to sharing more positive news with the community as information becomes available.
