The following supplies are still needed:

N95 Masks - 3M1870+, 3M9210+ and 3M9211+

 $\cdot$  Surgical Gowns –disposable, elasticized cuffs, cover front and back with ties to fasten and be fluid resistant

• Face Shields – need to cover the entire face, manufactured of a clear, antifog material, disposable, adjustable, be capable of being worn over eye glasses

• Hand Sanitizer – be a minimum of 99.0% effective against a broad range of bacteria, be alcohol based with a minimum concentration 60%, be available in personal size containers

Anyone with a supply of the items listed is asked to contact the staff person below to determine pickup and delivery arrangements. Thank you in advance for helping to contain the spread of COVID-19 and keep our health care and front line staff safe.
