Kawartha Lakes Splash Pads to remain closed for now

Although the province has given the green light for pools and splash pads to reopen in some regions June 12, those in Kawartha Lakes will remain closed for now.

"Our municipality will not be in a position to open anything on Friday, but pools and splash pads are some of the recreational amenities currently being looked at by staff. A detailed update of our service provisions moving forward will be provided shortly," says Craig Shanks, director of Community Services for the City of Kawartha Lakes.

The provincial government announced Phase 2 of Reopening Ontario in certain regions, including Kawartha Lakes, June 8, including all swimming pools, wading pools and splash pads.
