Local health works to keep doctors supplied with flu vaccine

HKPR health unit has distributed about 42,000 doses

The local health unit continues to weather the bumps in the road when it comes to distributing influenza vaccine to area health care providers.

According to medical officer of health Dr. Lynn Noseworthy, the Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge District Health Unit has shipped roughly 42,000 flu shot doses - enough to cover more than 22 per cent of residents in Northumberland and Haliburton counties and City of Kawartha Lakes - and is keeping supplies that arrive weekly at Port Hope and Lindsay offices moving to health care providers.
