KAWARTHA LAKES-The Ontario Provincial Police is restricting the access to its facilities, including detachments, across the province due to the latest provincial lockdown.

The OPP is limiting the processing of routine criminal record checks/vulnerable sector checks and finger printing to essential workers/volunteers only. Anyone seeking entry to the City of Kawartha Lakes OPP Detachment **must** make an appointment first. Individuals will be pre-screened and are required to have proper personal protective equipment prior to entering the detachment.

If you require any detachment-based service, including criminal record checks/vulnerable sector checks, please call (705) 324-6741 in advance for an appointment. Our operating hours are 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.
