The Ontario government has announced new plans for vaccine allocation, as a result of the current delivery shortage of Pfizer-BioNTech doses across the country.

This week, Ontario will not be receiving any Pfizer vaccines, the government announced in a brief on Jan. 25. This is due to Pfizer's recent decision to scale up its plant in Belgium, resulting in [temporary delivery reductions](#) in Canada and Europe.

As well, the week of Feb. 1, Ontario is expecting just over 26,000 doses — a
