Zero Pfizer-BioNTech vaccines being allocated this week: province

The Ontario government has announced new plans for vaccine allocation, as a result of the current delivery shortage of Pfizer-BioNTech doses across the country.

This week, Ontario will not be receiving any Pfizer vaccines, the government announced in a brief on Jan. 25. This is due to Pfizer's recent decision to scale up its plant in Belgium, resulting in temporary delivery reductions in Canada and Europe.

As well, the week of Feb. 1, Ontario is expecting just over 26,000 doses -a
