CHATHAM, C. W.,

A town in the Township of Raleigh and County of Kent. It is the chief town of the county, and is situated on the River Thames, about 18 miles from where that river debouches into Lake St. Clair. The river is navigable to Chatham for vessels of the largest class. Chatham is in the centre of a rich agricultural county; it has some fine public buildings; the Great Western Railway has a station near its southern limits. A large business is carried on here in lumber, wheat, flour, soap, candles and pot and pearl ashes. There is also a woollen factory here that is doing a very fine business. The hotels are very fair—the Royal Exchange is the best in the town; distant from Niagara Falls 198 miles, Toronto 176 miles, Hamilton 155 miles, London 79 miles, and from Windsor 31 miles. Daily mail. Population 4,402 by census of 1861.
