## **KENSINGTON HOUSE**

This house was built in the 1860s, but the current Queen Anne style remodelling occurred in 1899, when it became New Jersey native Sarah Bothwell's summer home. The decorative woodwork on the exterior is known as Eastlake decoration after American architect Charles Eastlake. 349 Henry St. 1899

## **SCOTT COTTAGE**

Built as a summer house for the Scott family from Washington, this compact brick Colonial Revival house originally had a wrap around verandah. The one-story wing was added about 1960. 197 King St. E. 1899
