

BANDSHELL


This bandshell replaced a gazebo style one which had served from 1902. Classical in style (proscenium arch flanked by pilasters), it was built on a non-vibrating base with a baffle of California redwood behind the shell. It is still used regularly by the Cobourg Concert Band and other performers. Victoria Park. 1934
